Topics this term:

- **Journeys**

Literacy

This half term we will be reading 'Shackleton's Journey' by William Grill. We will be focussing on the description of characters and settings, creating newspaper reports, letters and diary entries based on events/ themes in the book.

Maths

This term the focus will be :

- Place Value
- Basic Arithmetic Skills— addition, subtraction, multiplication & division.
- Fractions
- Geometry—Position & Direction.

Problem solving and reasoning will be a feature in every lesson to encourage children to apply their skills.

Please note a rapid recall of the times table facts is key to all learning in maths & children are expected to access Timetables Rockstars daily.

Guided Reading

During guided reading sessions we will be supporting the children to gain a deeper understanding of the texts they read. In school we will focus on Vocabulary, Inference, Prediction, Explanation, Retrieval and Summaries (VIPERS.)

It is still very important to listen to your child read even though they may be a competent reader; as studies show that a child who reads regularly to an adult make more progress than those who don't.

You can help your child at home by asking questions such as:

- Why do you think _____?
- How do you know that _____?
- How do you feel about _____?
- Can you find words in the text that are similar in meaning to _____?

Reading books can be changed as soon as Home/School Journals are signed. Please ensure that your children are reading most nights and their diaries are signed by an adult.
