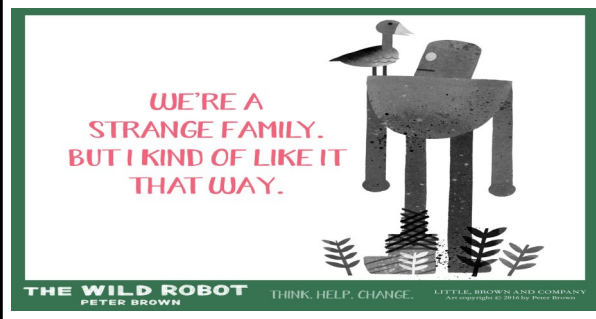
Topic this term:

ENGLISH

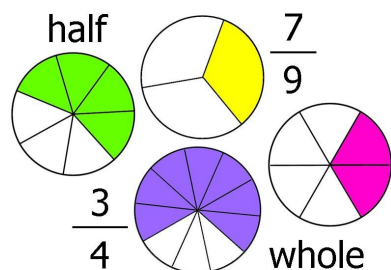
In English this term we will be using the text "The Wild Robot" by Peter Brown, to help us explore concepts of difference, survival and what life must be like for refugees.

We will explore the book using it to inspire a wide range of writing, including poetry, stories and reports.



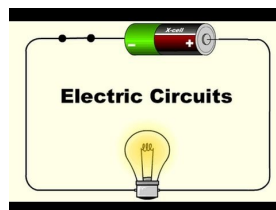
MATHS

This term we will be focusing on fractions and decimals. Y4 will also be working hard on their times tables to prepare for the Y4 test at the end of the year.



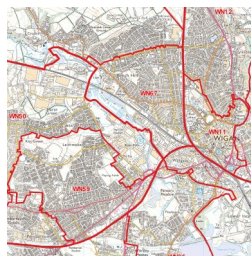
Science

This half term we will be studying electricity. We will explore the history of electricity, how electricity is produced and of course we will be building our own electrical circuits.



Geography & History

This term we will find out about the counties of England, in particular, Greater Manchester. We will conduct local studies, carrying out field work using Ordnance Survey maps and learning how to read a compass. In history we will explore the changes in music, including musical instruments and their influences music has had on society in the U.K.
