
## Year 3/4

## ENGLISH

In English this term we will be exploring stories from around the world through the anthology of stories by Hugh Lipton called Tales of Wisdom and Wonder. We will explore the book using it to inspire a wide range of writing, including poetry, story and reports.



## Science

## Art


This term the theme is Take one picture. We will use one picture, a wall relief carving of the Egyptian pharaoh
